They meet regularly with people who are often vulnerable to exploitation, victims of abusive relationships and often without other resources to remove themselves from this situation. They have the opportunity to share the love of Jesus, pray with them, encourage them to see themselves as valuable, worthy of respect and created in the image of God. They have helped some explore furthering their education, hosted retreats to encourage them and generally shine the love of Jesus into their lives.

Next week our special designated offering is for CAMA. CAMA is an important local ministry that coordinates ecumenical events in the greater Cadillac community. CAMA has underwritten a hospital chaplain at Munson Hospital Cadillac for several decades. The hospital's chaplain sees 100 patients and families per month and coordinates around the clock chaplain availability to them
