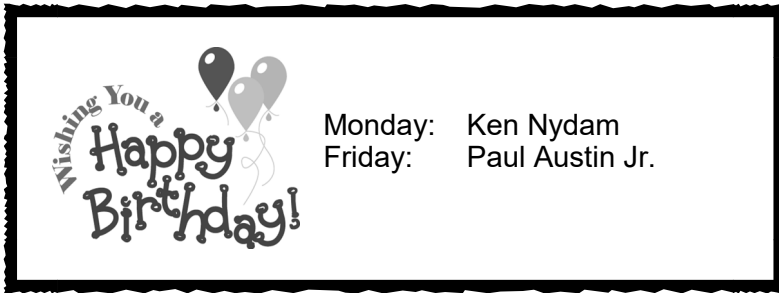
Prayers and sympathies go to Marge Brinks, Jean Webster and families on the sudden passing of their brother, Harvey Pluger.
