Update from the Slacks. We're nearing our first year anniversary in London! In twelve short months, we've built strong relationships with local churches, new church plants, and mission organizations across North London as we share the gospel in the most deprived, diverse, and densely populated neighborhoods in the city. The baseline for non-Christians in the area is 60%, most of whom come from unreached people groups like Turks. We've been teaching English classes, hosting Bible studies, doing 1-on-1 discipleship, and teaching and preaching across the borough of Enfield. We're so thankful for your prayers and generosity that make it possible for us to do this important kingdom work.

Prayer Requests: Pray for Matt's English class students (mainly Turks) and that God provides opportunities to share the gospel as we teach and get to know them. Pray for Emily's weekly Bible Study with Turkish Muslim women as they explore John's gospel together. Pray for Juniper (11) as she navigates new places, friendships, and church environments.
