Please pray that Glen Van Antwerp's chemotherapy treatments completely eradicate all his recurring cancer and pray for manageable side effects throughout the process.


Please continue to pray for Lawson Wistinghausen with his fight with cancer. Please continue to pray for Lawson's healing and pain relief.
