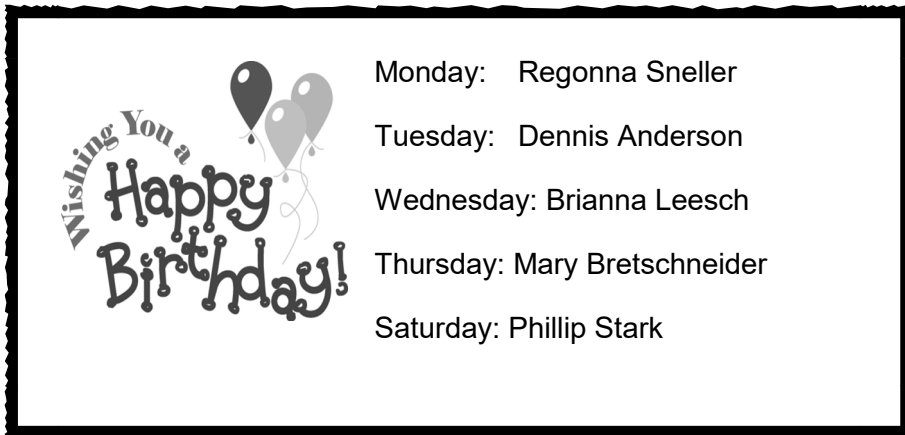
Please pray that Glen Van Antwerp's chemotherapy treatments completely eradicate all his recurring cancer and pray for manageable side effects throughout the process.
