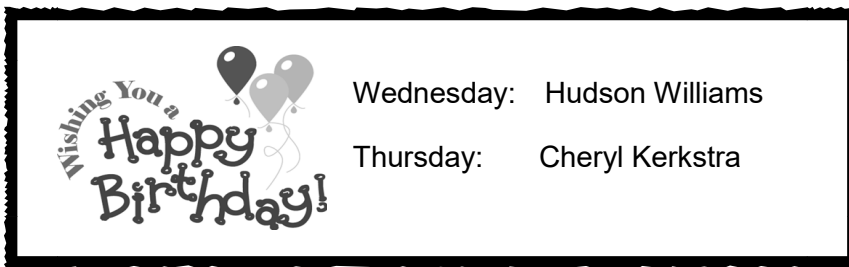
Pray for Phil and Sandy Stark. Phil is regaining strength slowly.
