Pray for Betty Tubergen. Betty was put in hospice care. Please continue to pray for Betty and her family during this time.

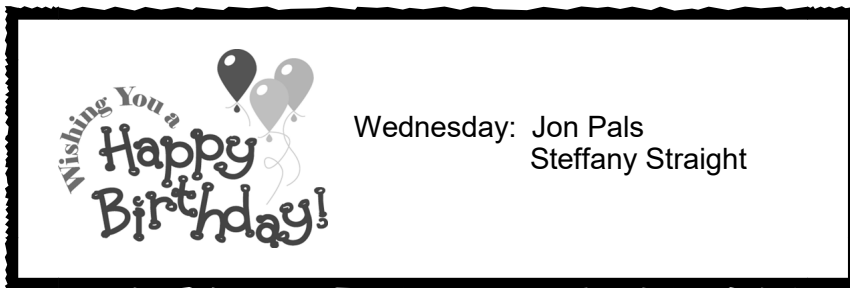
Please continue to pray for Lawson Wistinghausen with his fight with cancer. We continue to pray for relief from pain and a miracle for Lawson.
