Pray for Cadillac CRC as we search for the person God is calling for our church.

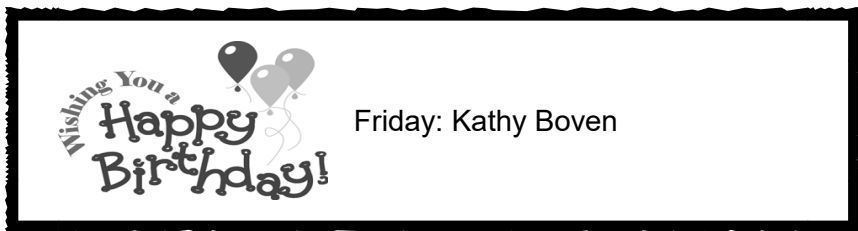
